For research within the ADME department, you use in vitro assays; cells; and analytical equipment, including LC-UV and high-resolution LC-MS. Assays that you will perform vary from solubility tests and determination of lipophilicity of substances to, for example, investigating the rate of metabolism of the substance in liver cells.
